  - 4 divides

  - Free self standing
  - Light and collapsible-saving storage and transportation cost.
  - For Khartoum-North Sudan, 3 polling booths should be packed in a carry bag.
  - For Juba-South Sudan, 4 polling booths should be packed in a carry bag.
  - Dimensions: minimum 155cm high, minimum 80cm wide and minimum 55cm deep. Desktop panel minimum 80cm from the ground.

Normal cardboard for Khartoum (North Sudan).  
Plastified cardboard for Juba (South Sudan).

Scenario 2:  
Normal cardboard for Khartoum (North Sudan) and Juba (South Sudan), **except for a total of 9,456 units on 3 Equatorial states.**

W Equatoria: 2,036 units
